



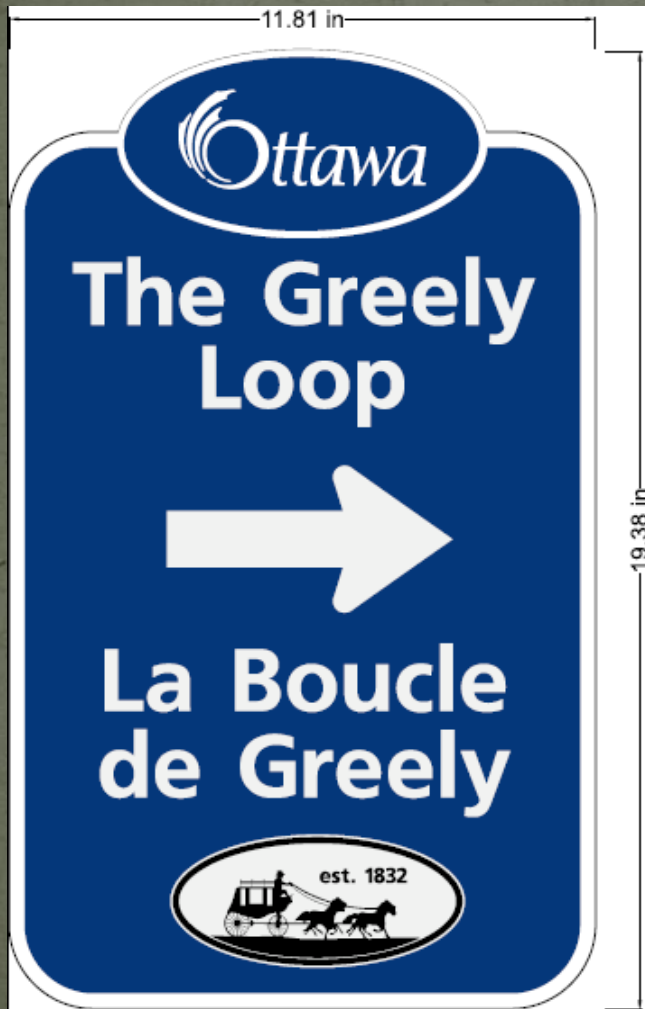

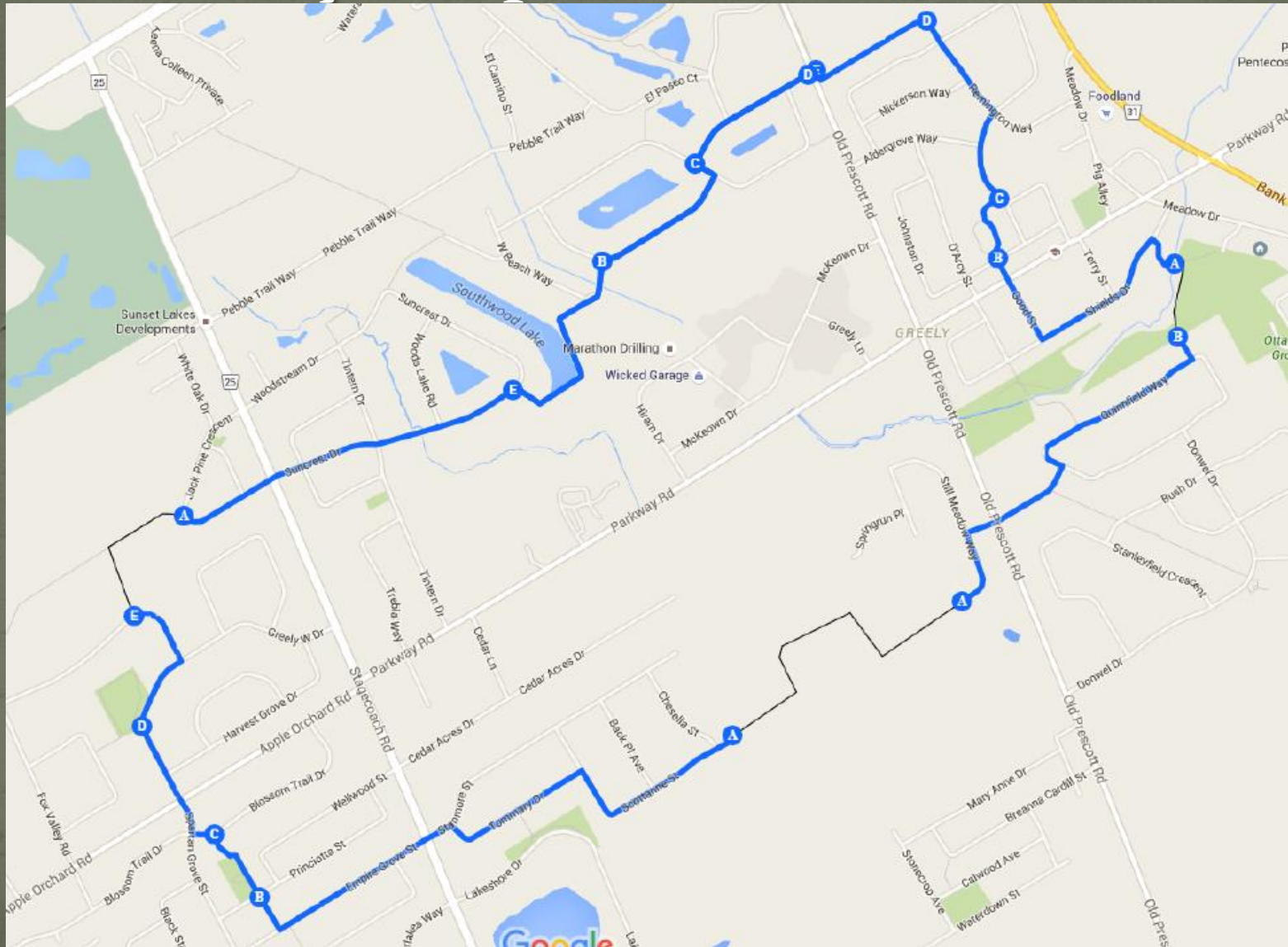
The Goal: To connect all Greely neighbourhoods with a safe, enjoyable pathway

- Community Centre, Parks and future Doug Thompson Multi-use Pathway

The Plan: Complete a loop trail with route indicator signage & safe crossings

- Using existing paths, quiet residential streets & new linkage paths
- South phase first – summer 2016
- Requires commitment from private land developers/owners

The Greely Loop: Recommended Route



Primarily existing trails and residential streets; requires 2 small linking trails to complete the loop
